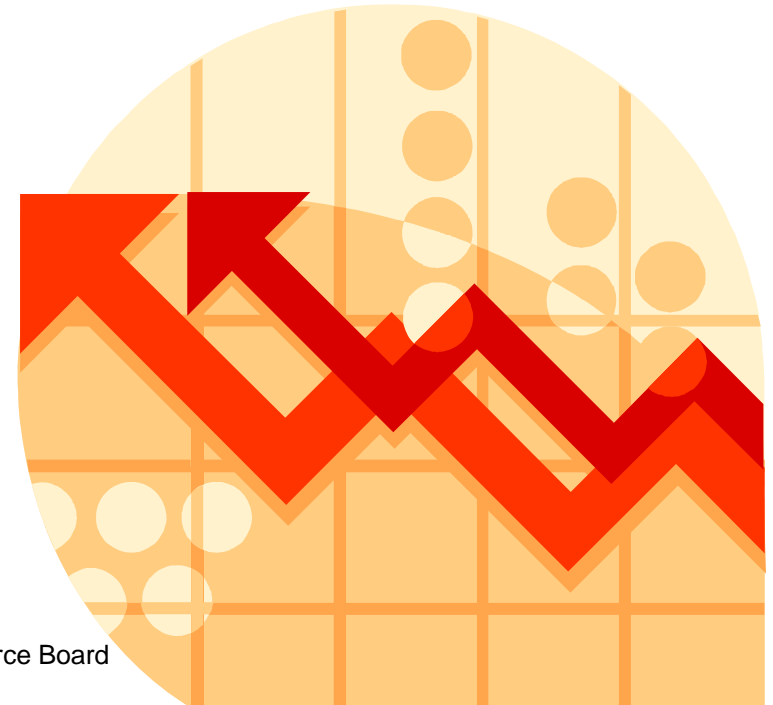


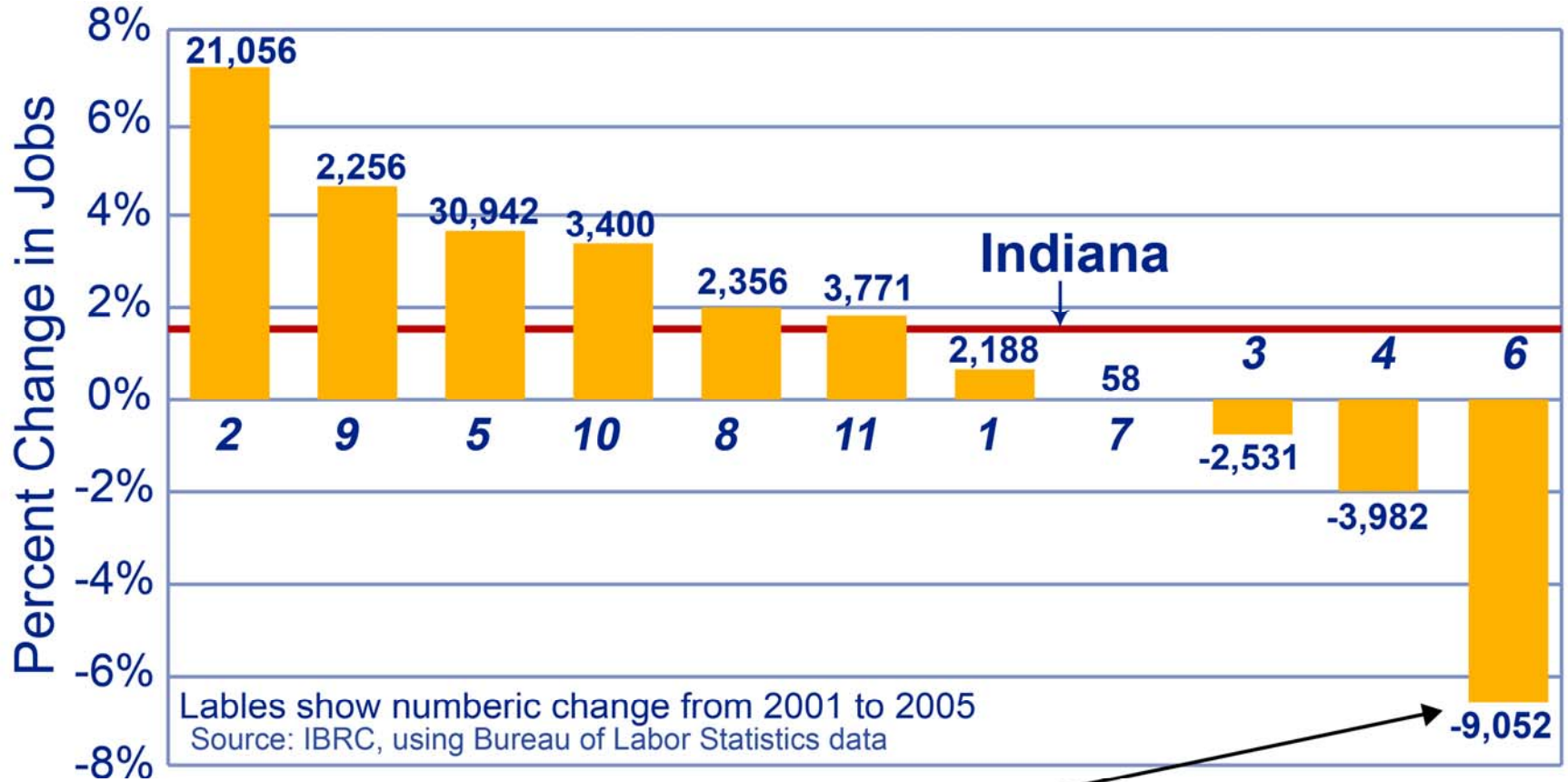

Indiana Economic Growth Regions

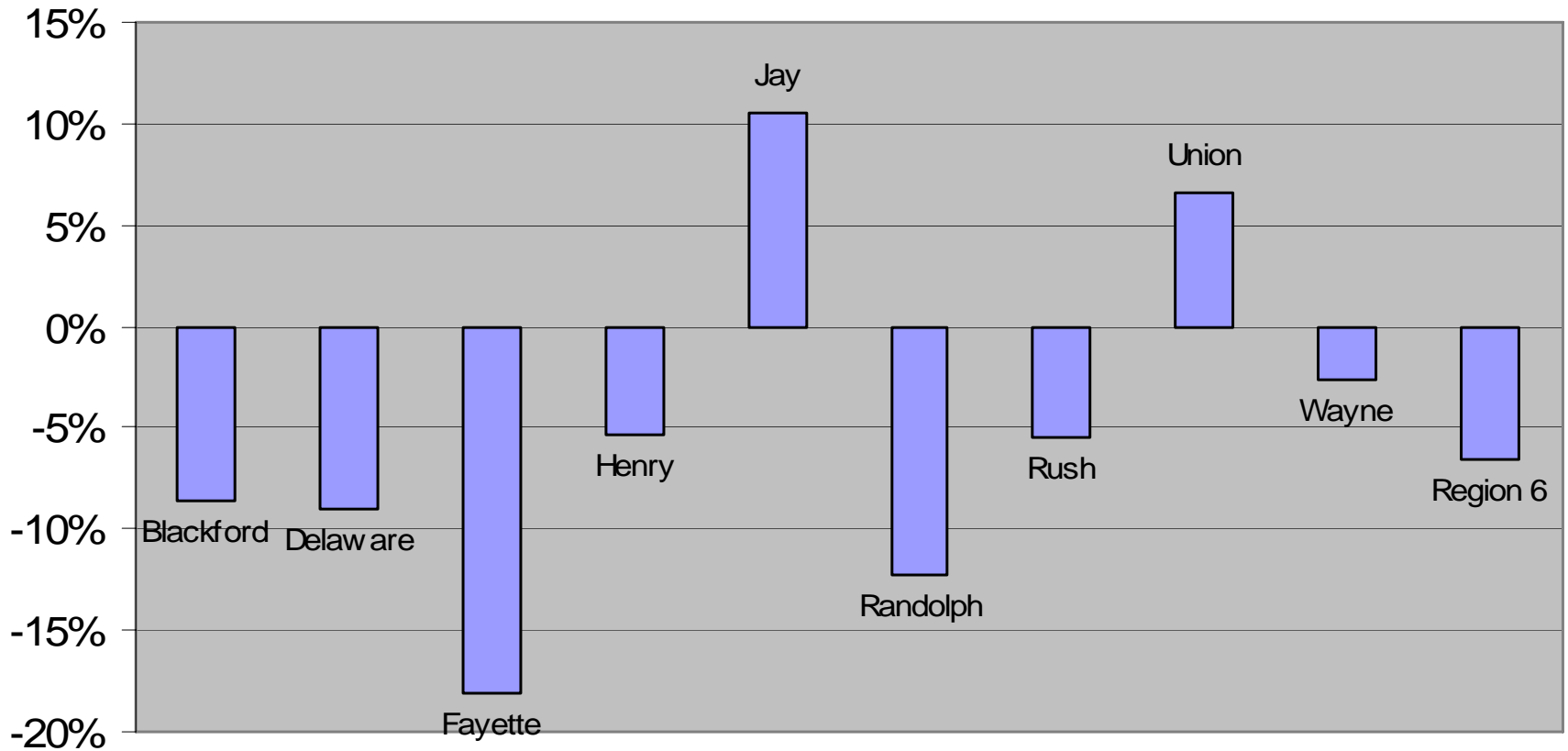
Change in Jobs by Region, 2001:4 to 2005:4

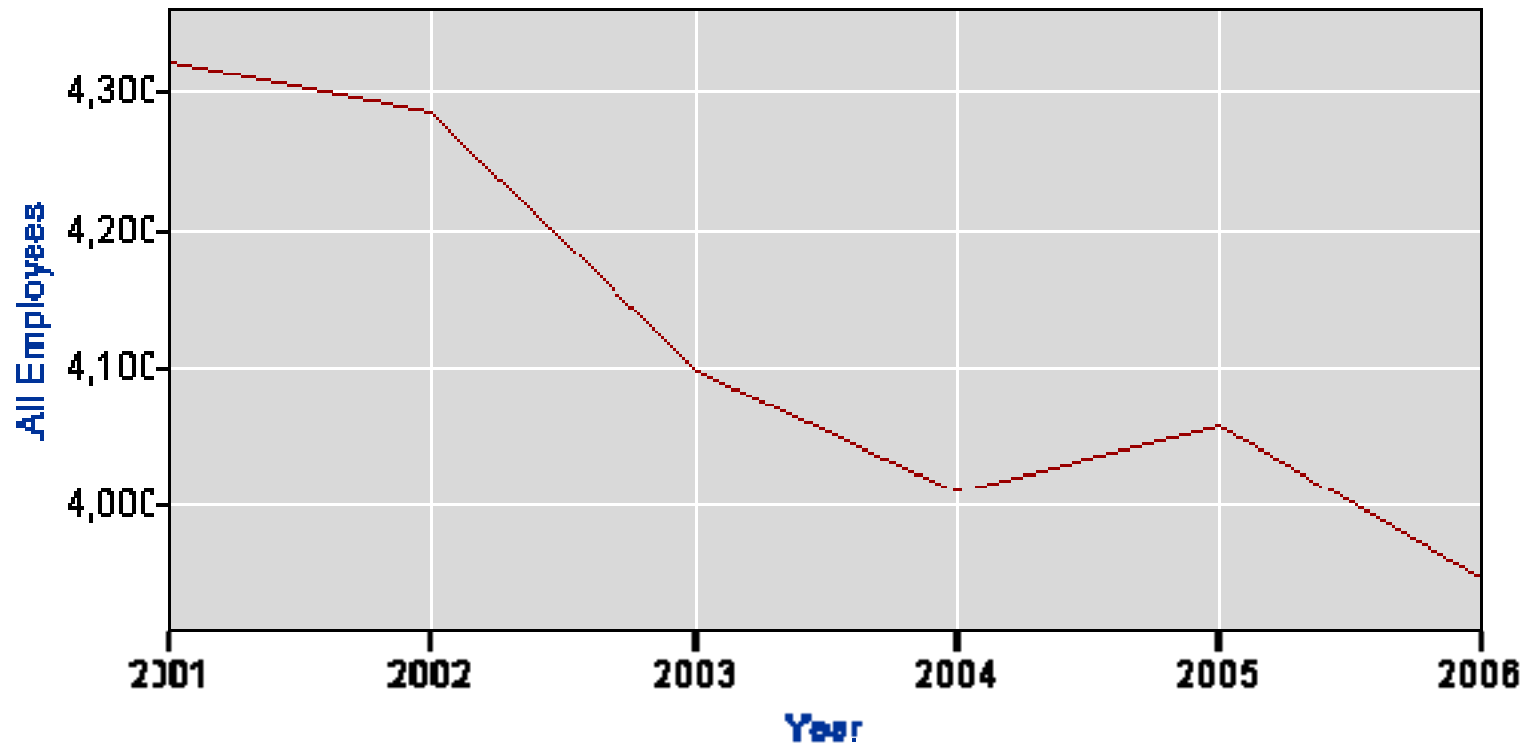
Eastern Indiana Economic Growth Region 6

Change in number of employed individuals by county: 2001 through 2006



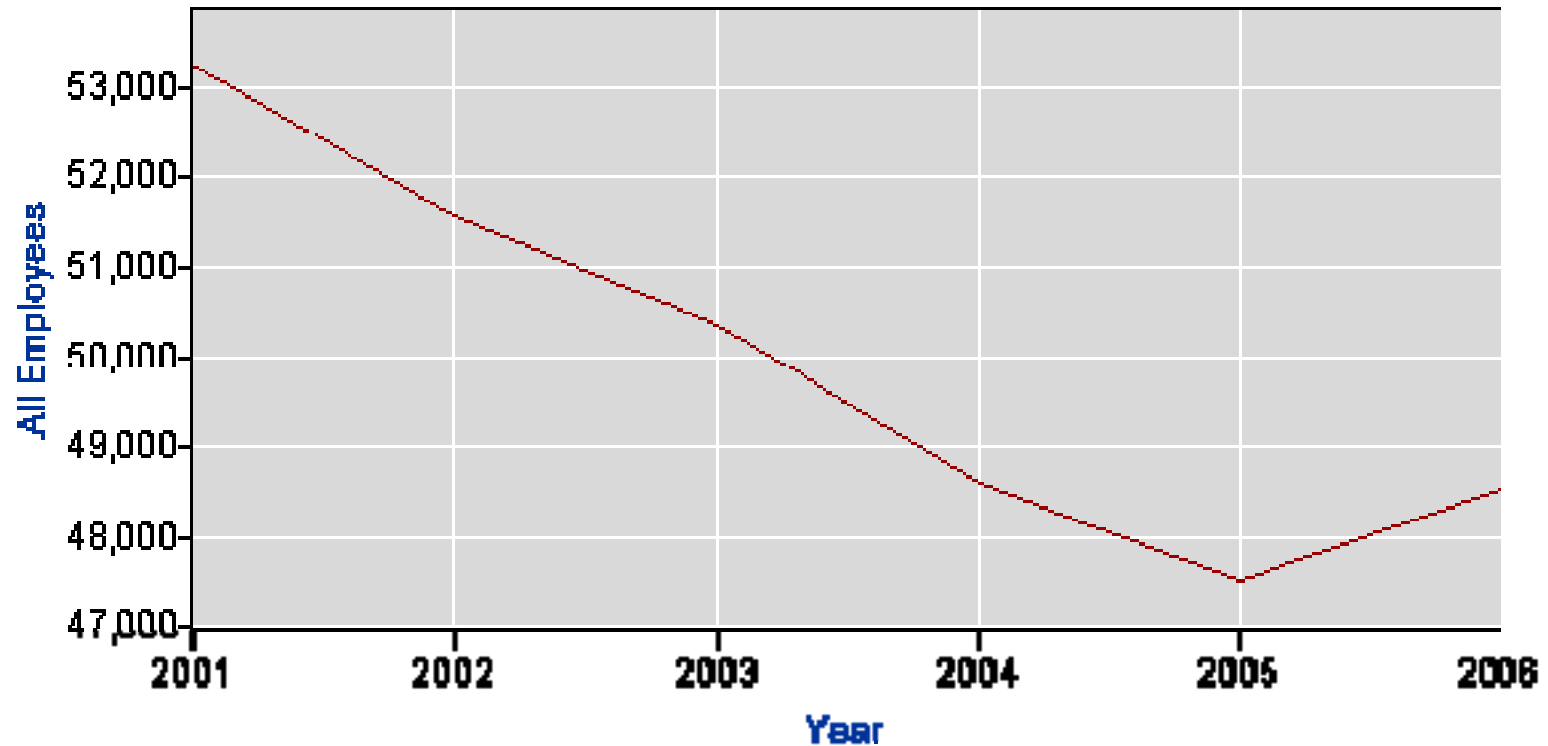

Change in Number of Employed Individuals 2001 - 2006



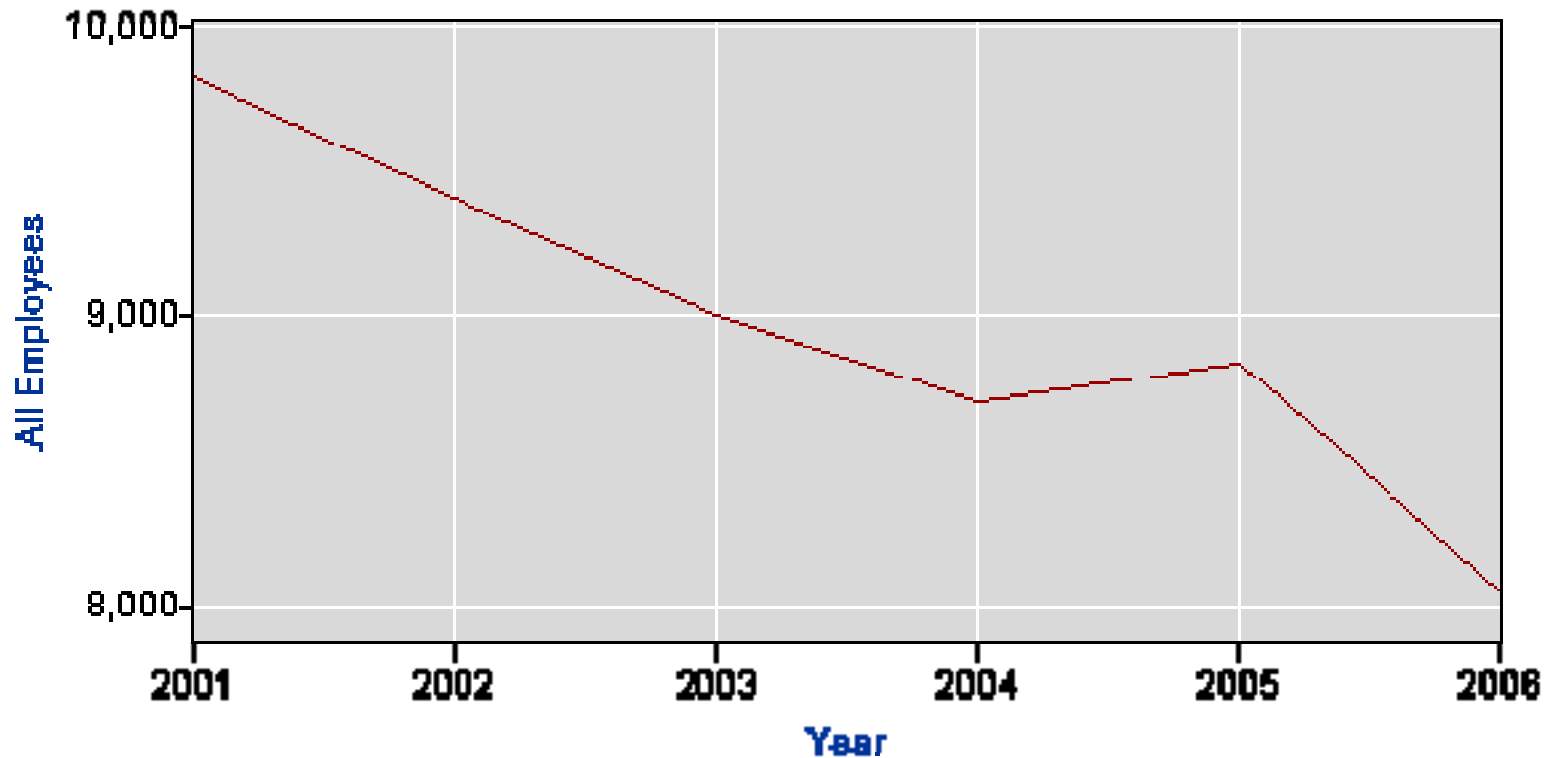
Delaware County

Change in Number of Employed Individuals 2001 - 2006



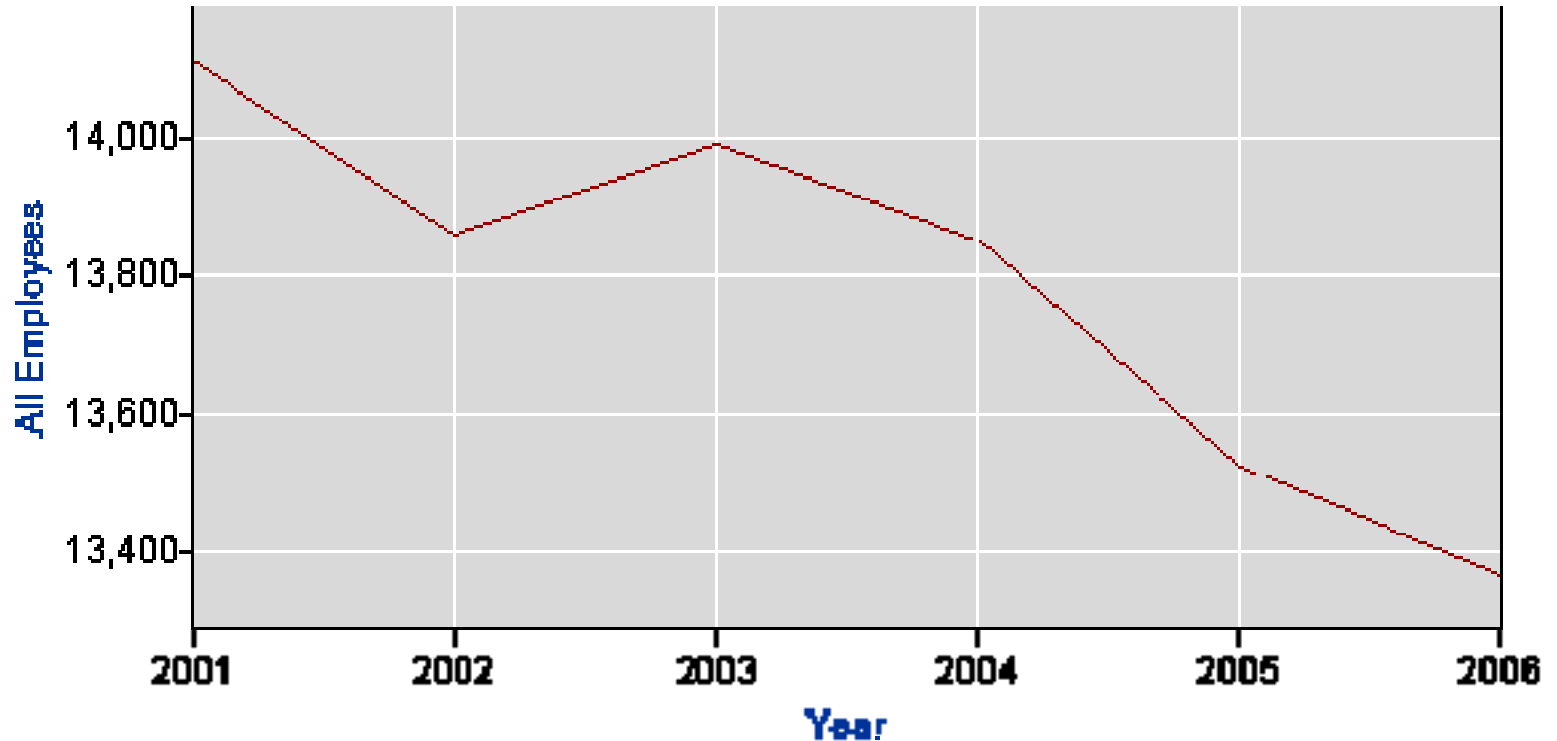
Fayette County

Change in Number of Employed Individuals 2001 - 2006



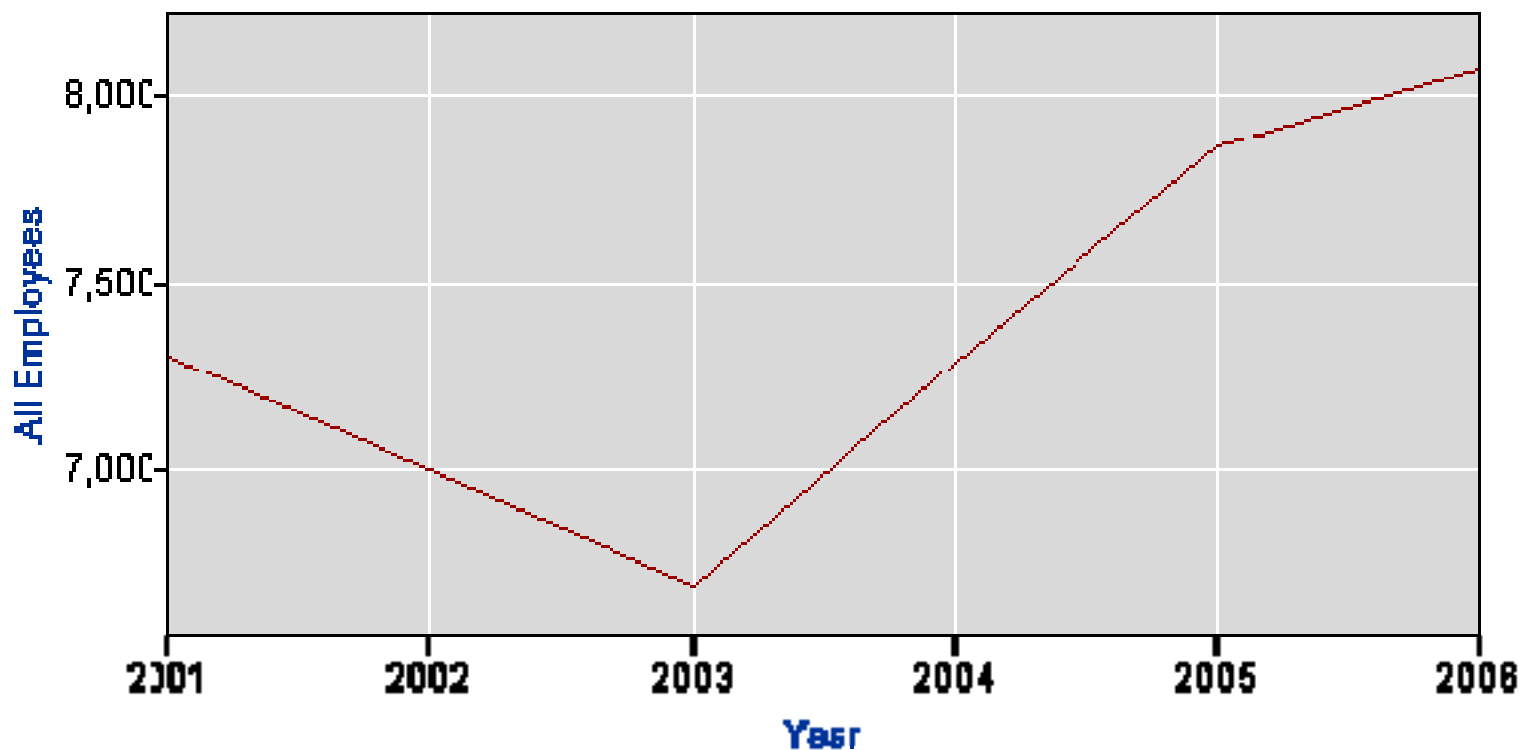
Henry County

Change in Number of Employed Individuals 2001 - 2006



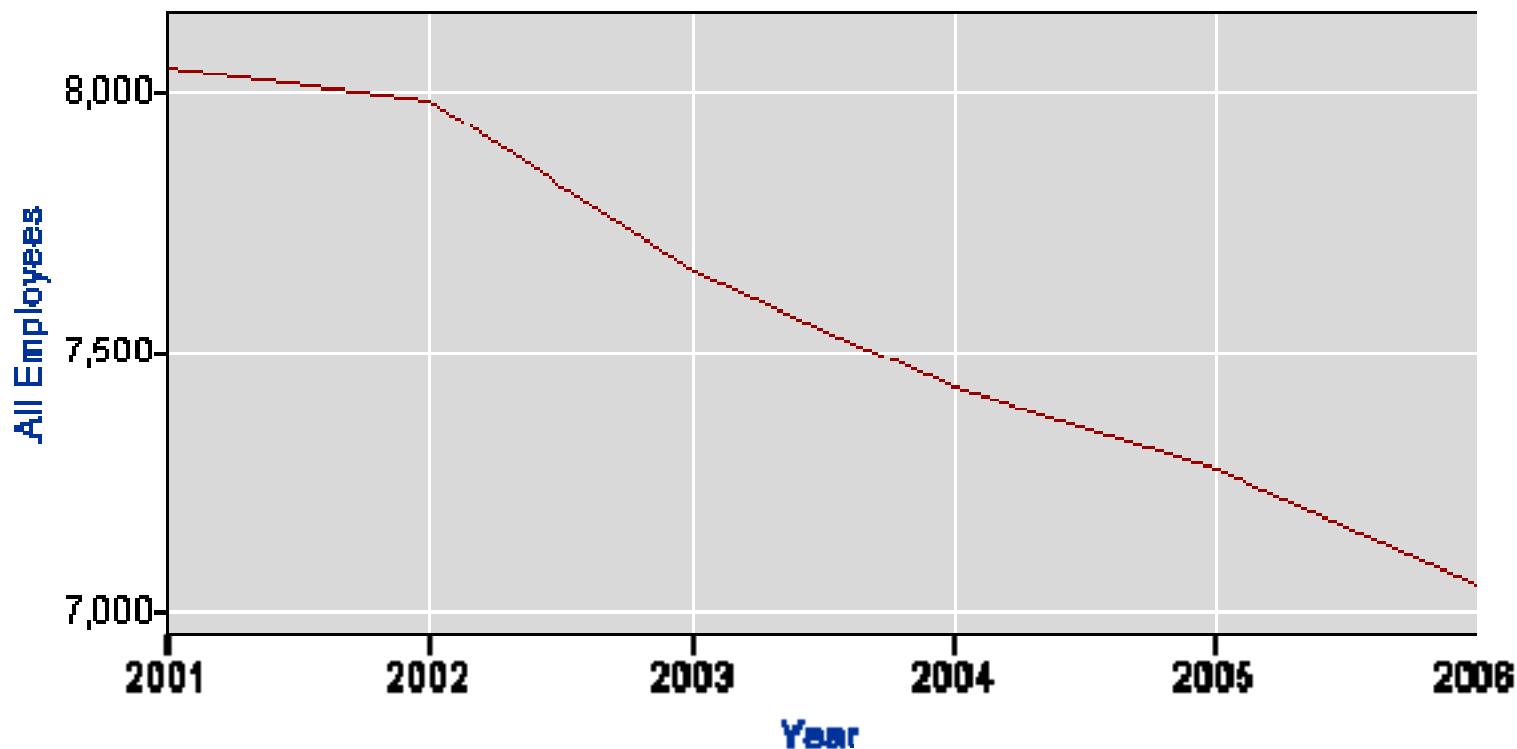

Change in Number of Employed Individuals 2001 - 2006



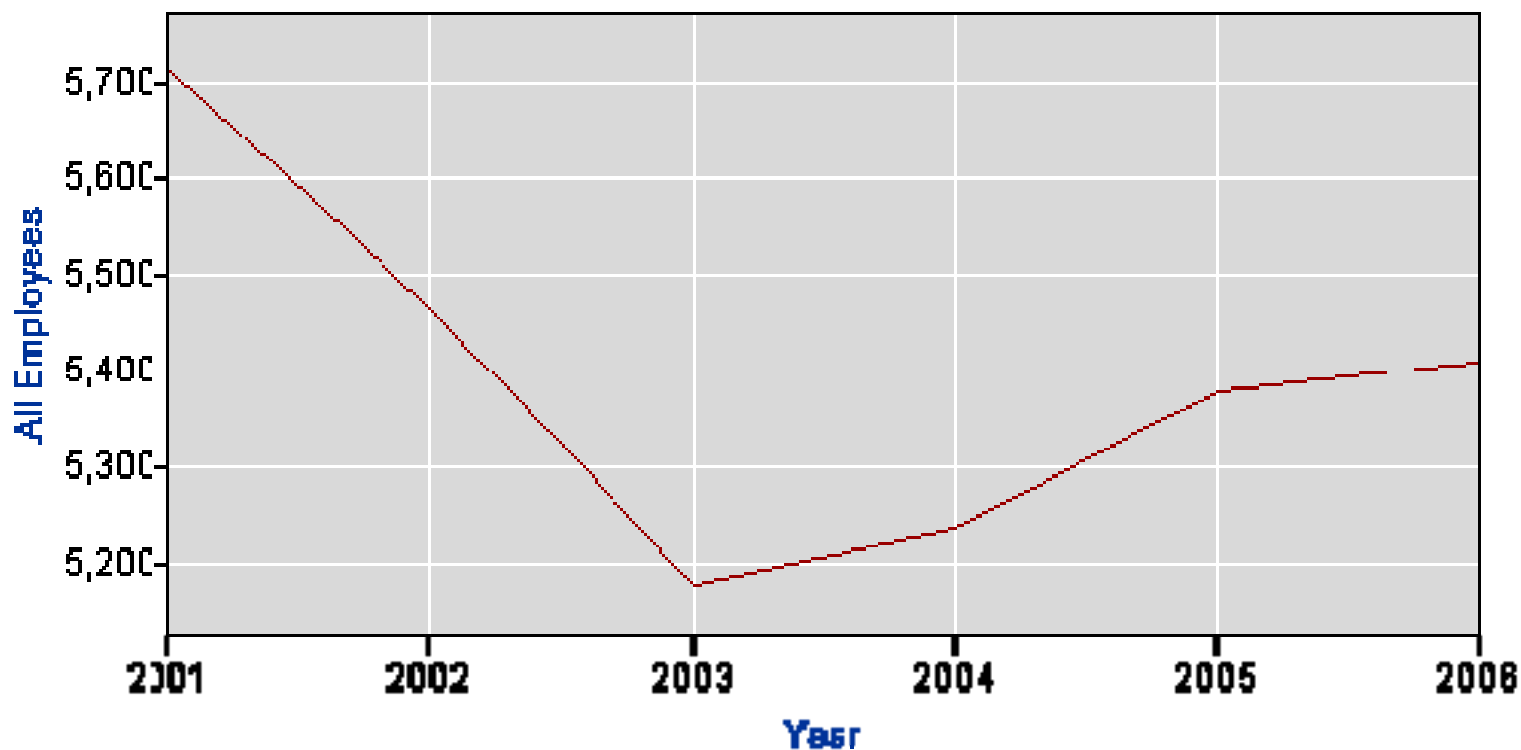

Change in Number of Employed Individuals 2001 – 2006



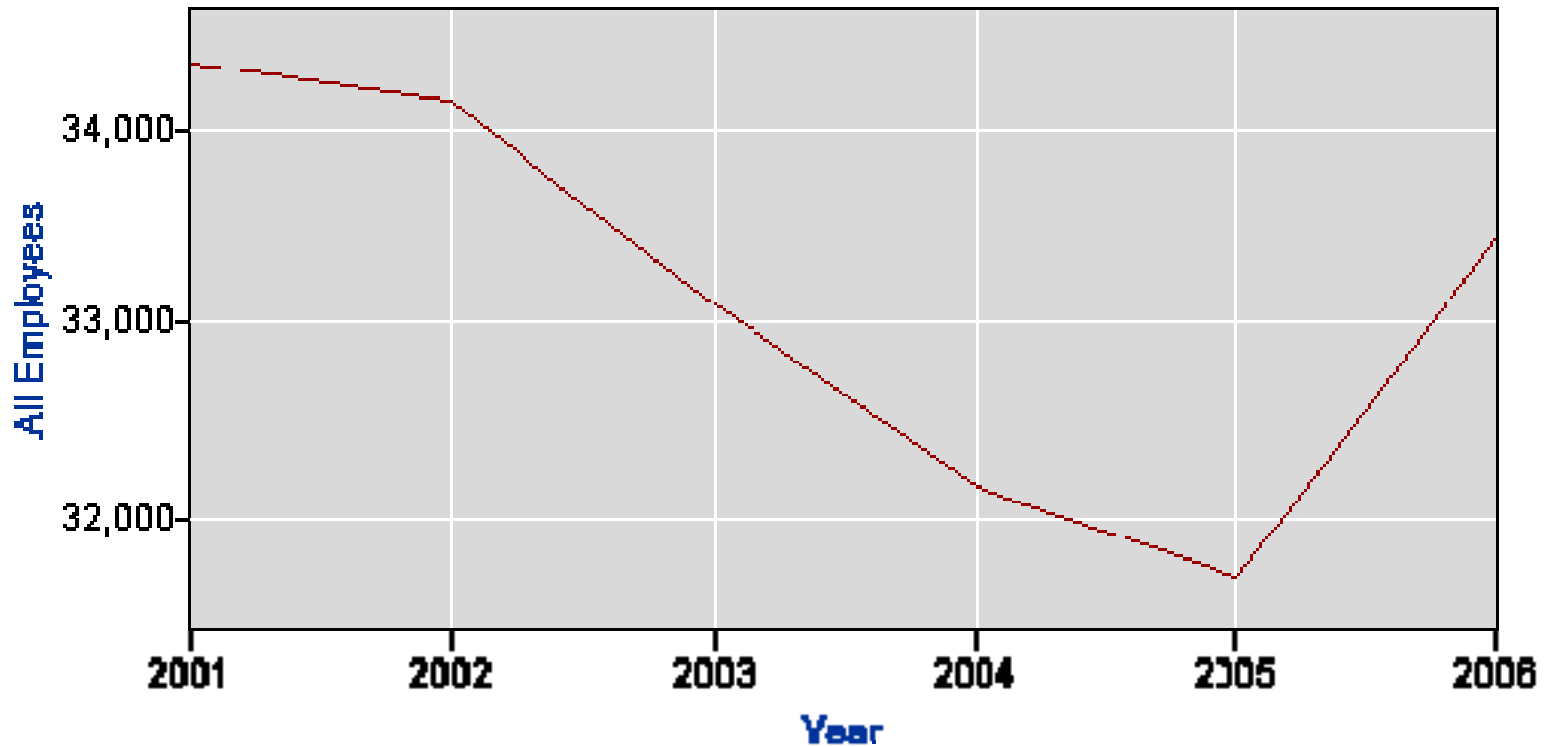

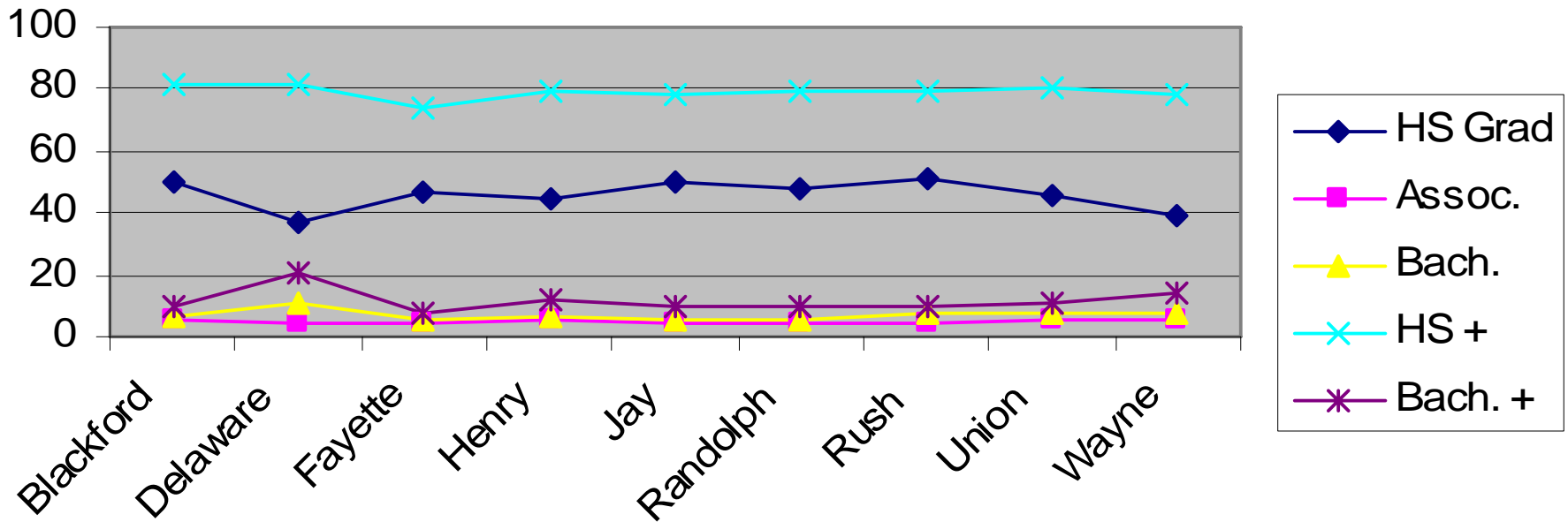

Educational Attainment by County US Census 2000



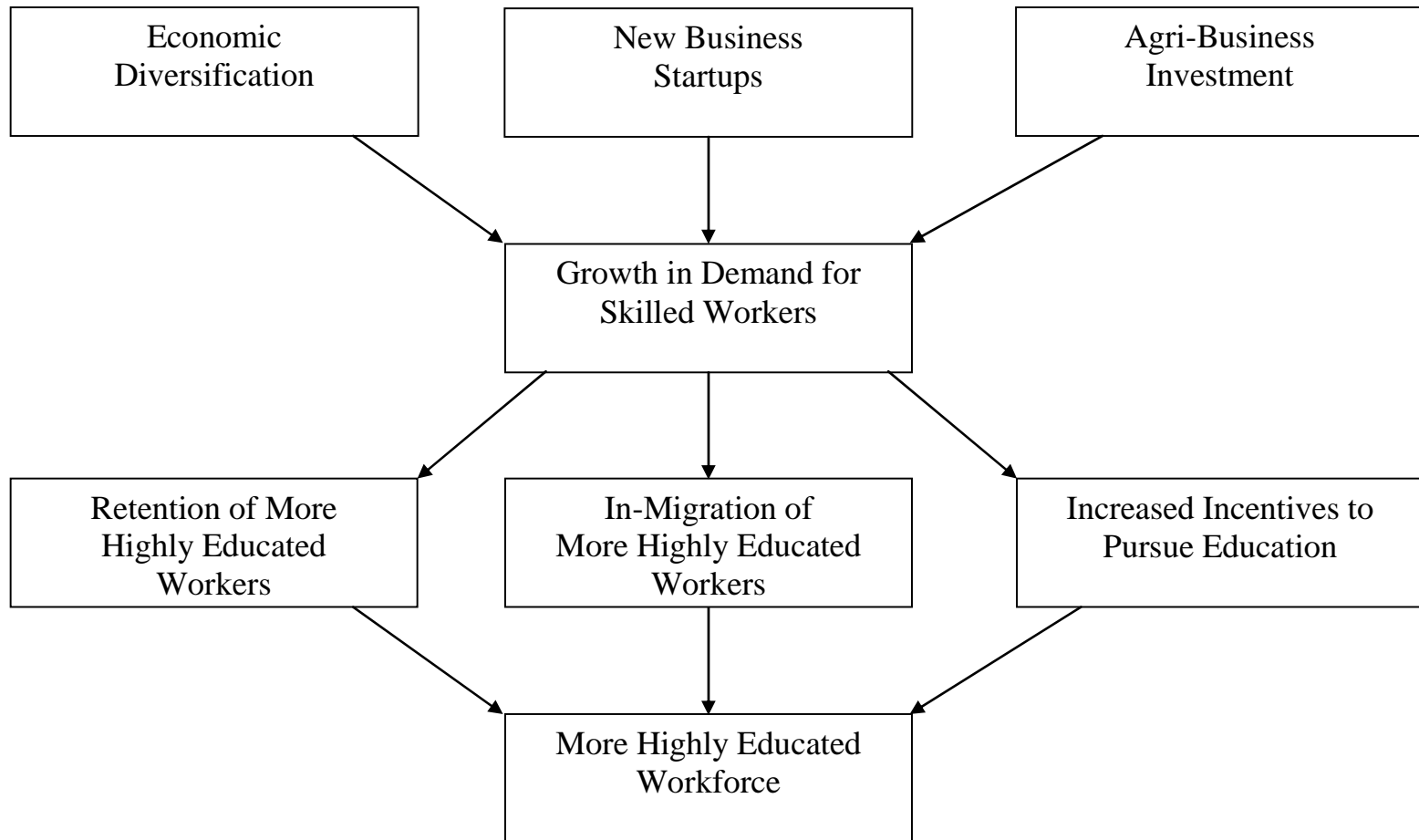

Pull Model of Increased Educational Attainment

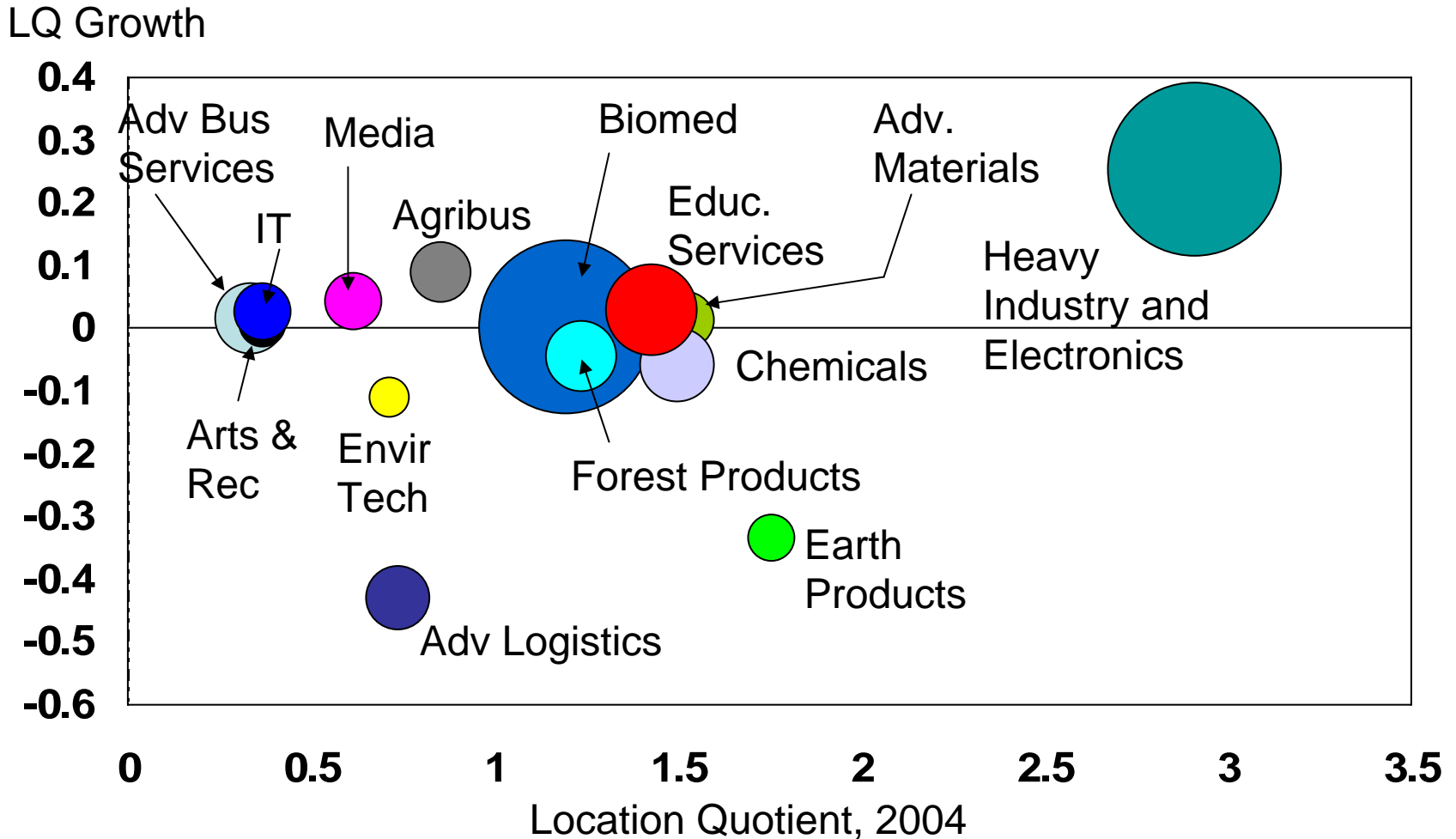


Symptoms versus Causes
